



On the night before his death Jesus had a final meal with his friends.

Jesus surprised his friends by washing the feet of every person, a task that was normally done by a servant. He wanted to show his followers that they should love one another in humble ways.

Foil Cross.

- 1. Cut out a cross shape from foam (you can use the fruit tray from the grocery store) or thick card board.
- 2. Wrap the cross tightly in aluminium foil and tape on at the back.
- 3. Decorate with an embossing tool or a ballpoint pen or not too sharp pencil.
